## Installation

- 1. Install Umbraco Package:** SpeedyImage 2.XX
- 2. Paste Example in Template**  
Replace bodyText with your Rich Text Editor alias.
- 3. Enjoy!**

## Usage

### MVC

```
SpeedyImage.Mvc.Go(string html, int height, int width, int maxheight, int maxwidth,  
bool constrain, int quality, string watermark)
```

### Example

```
@Html.Raw(SpeedyImage.Mvc.Go(CurrentPage.bodyText, 0, 0, 600, 800, true, 88,  
"/media/1003/watermark.png"))
```

### Manual

```
/SpeedyImage.ashx?imagepath=[path]&height=[int]&width=[int]&maxheight=[int]  
&maxwidth=[int]&constrain=[true|false]&quality=[1-100]&watermark=[path]
```

### MVC Manual

```
SpeedyImage.Mvc.GoUrl(string url, int height, int width, int maxheight, int maxwidth, bool constrain,  
int quality, string watermark)
```

## Cache (Optional)

### Web.config Appsettings

To activate caching, paste the following in your Web.config AppSettings  
<add key="SpeedyImage.CacheInterval" value="15" />

## Umbraco Resizing (Recommended)

Umbraco will add "style" to your <img> tags. Disable resizing to use responsive images.  
**Developer > Datatypes > Richtext editor > Maximum size for inserted images = 0**
